EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Entries: Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, and must be postmarked no later than the closing date. All entries must include payment and must be signed in all applicable places on the back of the entry form. A Neg. Coggins, dated within the last 12 months, is required for Ohio Entries, or one dated within six months for out of state entries. Post entries will be accepted if scheduling permits, with an additional \$10.00 fee per test. If scheduling does not allow for additional exhibitors, then a waiting list will be formed to fill any scratches that occur. There will also be a \$10.00 fee when a change is made to an entry after the closing date.

Opportunity Classes: Riders entering only the Opportunity classes do not need to pay the USEF drug fee, USEF/USDF non-member fees or the USDF HID fees. If riders also enter into the USDF Introductory classes, then the USEF (drug) fee only will be required. Cross-entering into Open or AA/JrYg classes will require the payment of all missing USEF/USDF non-member & USDF HID fees. Riders who are USEF members must still list their Federation number. Scores from all Opportunity classes are sent to the USEF & USDF, but are not recorded or counted for year-end awards.

Awards: Six ribbons per class, plus an extra 1st Place Award for each class that has five or more participants. A high-percentage point award will also be given in each level (overall for the 2-day GHS Show.) Intro level, Opportunity and Young Horse classes do not count towards extra awards. In the Training & 1st Level Classes, there will be a separate award for the Junior/Young Rider high-% score & Adult Amateur high-% score, overall for the 2-day GHS Show. All Freestyles count as one level, and all the FEI tests, count as one level, for the high-% award. There must be at least 4 exhibitors in a level for the award to be given. Some winners will be determined after the riders have already left the grounds, & in that case the awards will be mailed to them.

Grand Haven Credits: Training through Second Levels: \$50 in credits (30/20) to be awarded to the top two entries in each designated (GH\$) class. Third, Fourth & All Freestyles: \$75 in credits (35/25/15) to the top 3 entries in each designated (GH\$) class. All FEI classes combined for the weekend: \$150 in credits (75/50/25) to the top three entries in the FEI (*GH\$) category. Credit vouchers will be awarded before the end of the weekend, & if any winners have already left the grounds, the vouchers will be mailed to them.
